We are overdue for an update, but there has been a lot going on, much of it "behind the scenes". For Brenna's Home, much of 2013 has been a year of adjustments. Valya is adjusting to mothering 12 twelve children with a diagnosis of rheumatoid arthritis. We are glad that medication is keeping her symptoms under control, for the most part. It has also been an adjustment dealing with twelve children day in and day out. Now that they have "adjusted", they are preparing for the likelihood of a new addition to the home, possibly by the end of November. We will wait to make it official until it happens. After five months of soul-searching, we have come to a realization that this place is on another continent, Africa - and more specifically, the nation of Ethiopia. Our work will continue in Ukraine, and we are now beginning the process of determining the specifics of how we will be used in We have made some preliminary Ethiopia. contacts, and Rich will travel there leaving December 30 and returning January 16. He will meet with a variety of people involved in serving the desperate children there. Ethiopia has 4.8 million orphans (that is the population of Philadelphia, Chicago, and Baltimore combined).
