Dear friends,

Recently we returned home from our Ethiopia trip. What a wonderful trip it was! We would like to share some of the highlights of the trip and what our Foundation is involved in there.



BRENNNA'S HOPE - Ethiopia

High School Girls Program

We are presently supporting 30 high school girls to help them complete their high school education. Many girls in the province of Tigray must walk up to two hours each way to school. This is a challenge for them because the school is so far away and walking can be dangerous. Our support of \$25 per month per girl allows them to live near the school and focus on their education. This helps to prevent rape and early marriage which may lead to health issues, such as fistula. We visited one of the high schools and met with 12 of the girls we support and heard their stories. Many come from very poor families with multiple siblings and are from single parent families. Our support allows them to finish their education and continue on to college. These girls are very motivated and grateful for the support given to them. PLEASE let us know if you would like to help in this area. There are many others waiting for a sponsor to help (\$25 a month). Here we are visiting Mere-Meity High School and seven of the high school girls, along with Denes House. The high school principal, Hiwet, is also in the back row. The girls in this photo are new students for us this year. They were all very shy and soft-spoken, so it was a very interesting time together.



Female University Students Program

Our second area of focus in Tigray is to provide support for girls for college. Our focus is on girls who are motivated, have a high grade point average, come from extreme poverty, and may be full or partial orphans. College is free if they pass the national entrance exam, but these girls need financial help for school supplies, monthly hygiene expenses, and travel to and from their homes. It costs \$20 a month per girl to provide the help they need. We have been supporting 38 girls for the last three years. During our trip we were able to meet with 11 of the students we support and hear about their progress. It was a pleasure to see how motivated they are and hear about their goals and aspirations for graduation. We hope to return in June, 2018 to attend the college graduation of the girls attending Mekelle University. We were able to provide each of the 38 college girls we support a flash drive (memory stick) which cost 5 dollars each. They were so happy to get their gift. Thank you to those of you who gave money for the flash drives. Pictured below are the eleven students we met from Mekelle University. Tadelech, in the photo with us is studying to be a veterinarian and has a perfect 4.0 average on her exams. The other student is Nigisti, majoring in chemical engineering.



There are many others who need support so if you are interested, it costs only \$20 per month to support a girl for her college education.

Hospital Visits in Mekelle

While in Tigray, the northern part of Ethiopia, we had the opportunity to visit two hospitals. The first hospital we went to was the Mekelle Branch of the Hamlin Fistula Hospital. This hospital is for woman who have suffered from a condition known as fistula; a condition when the birth canal is ruptured during childbirth. It is common with women who give birth at an early age (common in Ethiopia if woman are not able to complete their education and therefore, are married off at an early age).

We were able to visit with several women post operatively as well as women waiting for surgery



to offer them comfort and support.



The second hospital was a large teaching hospital. The director of nursing gave us a tour of each unit. The hospital was just starting a homecare program and was very interested in speaking with Donna due to her extensive background in homecare nursing and Hospice.

Unfortunately, rape is common in Ethiopia. We also visited a new center, pictured here, which was just opened by Hope Community Services (our partner in Tigray) to house and provide counseling to those young woman who have been raped.

program decided not to continue, we are now planning the structure we will use to continue to provide needed support for these children as their mothers improve their lives.

Central Ethiopia - "Adopt-a-Family"

Three years ago when Rich made his first trip to Ethiopia, he met a 10 year old girl in Debre Zeit named Beza. She made a real impression on him and we were determined to reconnect with her and her family. We were able to find her and visit her, her mother and three younger sisters. Her mother is a single, hard working parent who earns the equivalent of \$3.75 per day as a construction laborer. The five of them live in one room, with two beds, one electric outlet, and a small set of shelves. They are allowed to live rent-free in this room while the house is under construction. We bonded immediately with them and asked our contact there how we could best help out to improve their lives. It was told to us that by improving the education



of the children, we could help provide a better life for them long term. We decided as a foundation to "adopt" this family. We are asking if anyone wants to provide



"private schooling" for them, it would cost \$35/ month per child. At present, we have one of the four girls sponsored. Please let us know if you are interested. Together we can change the lives of a whole family! Here is a picture of all four girls with their mother.

Central Ethiopia - Rehab Women and Children

The second part of our trip was visiting Addis Ababa and Debre Zeit in Central Ethiopia. We have had a small ministry in Debre Zeit where we provide education and



daycare support for children whose mothers have left prostitution and are in the process of rehabilitation. It costs just 30 dollars a month to provide care for one of



these children. It was a joy for us to meet some of the women and children in this program. While the
