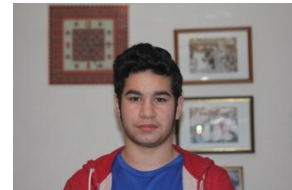

Summer Camp

Every two years, we try to take a team and provide a summer camp opportunity for the children in the Tabitha Program at Resurrection Church. Normally we hold a five-night sleepover camp for about 65-70 kids. This year we are taking on a larger endeavor. We will do a six-night camp for 90 kids. The children will come from Lutsk and the nearby town of Kivertsy, which has also started a Tabitha Program in the church there. We have assembled an outstanding team from the USA and Ukraine: In addition to Rich and Donna, Tom Slaughter, Natalia Bundy, Mike and Brianna DeCarmine are coming from New Beginnings Church in



Poughkeepsie, NY; Christina Polk from Garland, Texas; Meisha Deane, and Randy and Annette Hillebrand from Kyiv will

join us. The camp will be at a large lake in Northwestern Ukraine about two hours drive from Lutsk. We can still use your help - we have 35 campers sponsored at \$95 each. You can help us defray the costs from our operating budget through sponsoring one or more children for camp. **You will get a personal thank you and a picture from the child you sponsor. We are praying that God will miraculously provide sponsorships for another 30, 40, or 50 children in the next 10 days.**

Exciting News!!!

Our oldest "daughter" in Brenna's Home, Sasha, has received a tourist visa to visit the USA for two months. Sasha (Alexandra) is 19 and is completing her second year of university, majoring in Economics. She will return with us July 13, when our team travels home from the summer camp trip. During her stay she will live with us, but will have many opportunities to experience American culture,



practice her English language skills, and be involved with many of the teens from our church. She will have chance to interact with sponsors, speak at

several churches, and have many day and weekend trips throughout the Northeastern United States. This will be the first time that any of the kids from Brenna's Home have had this opportunity. Sasha will return to Ukraine September 16 in time for her to continue her education.

Brenna's Hope-Ethiopia



High School girls - Tigray Province

We work with Hope Community Services in Northern Ethiopia to provide monthly support for vulnerable high school girls to complete their education. In this region of Ethiopia, many girls walk two hours or more EACH WAY to attend high school. This means they face dangers while walking in darkness, and also makes it difficult for them to complete their studies. Consequently they may drop out of school and are frequently used as wives for arranged marriages, even as young as ages 13 to 17. If this happens and they become pregnant, they face challenges with childbirth because their bodies are not fully developed. This may result in a condition known as [fistula](#). Our focus is PREVENTION.

We sponsor 30 girls for this program and are still seeking a few more sponsors to meet our goal! Just \$25 a month will provide a shelter and food close to school or transportation services for these girls at great risk.

These girls are responsible for carrying water to their homes before they leave for school, or again after school. Often these girls will walk together in groups for safety from those who might try to take advantage of them.

Student Spotlight

Fotein is completing grade 10 at Mere-Meity Secondary School and we were privileged to meet her during our February trip. She comes from a



very poor family and is one of eight children. She is a very determined student who has a two-hour walk each way to attend school. Her home is 8 km (5 miles) from the school. Her family subsists on crops from farming a small plot of land.

College girls - Tigray Province

We also sponsor female college students in conjunction with Hope Community Services. Many girls graduating from high school who are orphans or from very poor families are excellent students and qualify for free tuition, room and board through a government program. However, the costs for travel and monthly hygiene expenses can be prohibitive for them to take advantage of the education. The cost for sending one of these girls to college is \$20/month (\$240/year). The first year we sponsored 30 girls, studying a variety of disciplines including electrical, chemical, civil engineering, veterinary medicine, accounting, land administration, public health and midwifery. After year two, eight girls had grade point averages of 3.5 and higher, and 19 had GPAs of 3.0 to 3.49! This year we are providing sponsorship for 38 girls for this program.
